Sparkling Wine

Champagne

Made from a combination of Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Pinot Meunier grapes in the French region of Champagne. The most highly esteemed of all sparkling wine.

Other sparkling wines

2015 La Prova Prosecco, King Valley VIC **65**

Prosecco is primarily made from the Glera grape, and its production is restricted to only a few select regions in Italy. Compared with Champagne, these wines carry a fuller texture and fruit whilst remaining quintessentially dry.

NV Schloss Gobelsburg Sekt Reserve, AUT **90**

'Sekt' is a German term for sparkling wine. Its premium examples are often made through Methode Traditionale, and can include, as this wine does, Pinot Noir, Riesling, and Grüner Veltliner. Crisp, fruit forward, delicious.

2012 Segura Viudas Gran Cuvée Reserva Brut, ESP **60**

Cava is the Spanish sparkling wine, native to the Catalan region. Its components include native Spanish grapes Macabeu, Parellada and Xarello.

2015 Sebastien Brunet "100%" Pet Nat Rose, FR **70**

Petillant Naturel, or Naturally Sparkling wines are different from most other sparkling wines as they are bottled during the initial fermentation, and as such see less secondary characteristics, in flavour of a crisp, dry, acid driven and fruit forward style.

The ways that white wine develops texture are myriad: oak, time spent on lees, fermentation techniques or indeed the flavour profile from each varietal will contribute to a broad mouth-feel and a long, satisfying finish

A Little Something Different

*Such a wonderful world of wine, so many delicious choices –
The following whites may be unfamiliar to some, but well
worth a look*

2013 *Domaine Pierre Luneau-Papin 'Terre De Pierre'* *Muscadet, Loire Valley FR 75*

Muscadet wine is made in the Loire Valley from the Melon de Bourgogne grape, which is quite neutral in flavour. Knowing this, Muscadet producers have taken to leaving the wine 'on lees', allowing the wine to take on more texture and a developed flavour from the yeast.

2014 *Suertes Del Marques 'Trenzado' Listan Blanco et al,* *Tenerife, Canary Islands ESP 90*

If you're looking for remote and captivating wine regions, it's hard to look further (literally) than the volcanic island of Tenerife off the Western coast of Africa. One of the native grapes there is Listan Blanco, and from this unique varietal the people at Suertes Del Marques produce this, their 'Trenzado' cuvee. Named for the trellising system the Listan vines are trained in, this wine is truly an adventure in texture, complexity and place.

2014 *Girolamo Russo 'Nerina' Etna Bianco, Sicily IT 95*

Few of the world's wine regions match the mystique of Etna, in Italy's southwest. Giuseppe Russo, a trained pianist and literature student, crafts his Etna Bianco from a majority of Carricante grapes grown on his organic estates, and produces a wine that carries superb palate weight and mineral drive, with dry citrus aroma and stonefruit character providing a base for a tantalising acid lift.

C.B.A. (Chardonnay, back again!)

Few grape varieties, if any, hold as much esteem globally as Chardonnay. From its birth home in Burgundy, to California, South Africa and our own backyard, this grape has flourished and endeared itself to wine lovers worldwide.

Rosé wine has been the quiet achiever in the wine world for a great many years. From the dry, herbaceous provincial styles to the more fruit driven New World expressions, the 'pink drink' has and will always have its place in the world's restaurants and bars.

Few regions in the world, if any, rival Bandol in the south of France for production of Rosé wine. Typically produced from Mourvedre, these are the benchmark worldwide for dry, herbaceous Rosés.

The Funky Bunch

There are more grape varieties in the world than one person could possibly know, and only a fraction of them will end up on our shores, many less on our tables – here's a short curated selection of some interesting styles to try.

2014 Pittnauer 'Pitti' zweigelt blend, Burgenland AUT 55

TF is Zweigelt? A crossing between the famed Austrian Blaufränkisch and St Laurent grapes and has quickly become a national treasure. An easygoing wine with ripe black fruit character, a little florality and Blaufränkisch signature spiciness.

2013 Elvio Cogno Dolcetto d'Alba Mandorlo, Langhe, Piedmont IT 65

Dolcetto D'alba is one of the lighter styles to come out of Piedmont, Italy, and is known for its light, floral palate and acid driven structure. Elvio Cogno has dedicated a long time to perfecting Dolcetto D'Alba as a style of wine and has come forth with a dry and elegant example showing red fruit, a perfumed bouquet and a light almond note on the finish which has come to be a signature of wines in this style.

2014 Girolamo Russo Etna Rosso 'A Rina', Sicily, IT 95

The Etna Rosso style is one of the hidden gems of southern Italy. Described as viticulture at its most perilous, the majority of the grapes are grown on the slopes of Europe's largest active volcano. The key grape, Nerello Mascalese, is a delight for those with a love for Pinot and Nebbiolo, with a firm acidity, good spice and pronounced structure.
